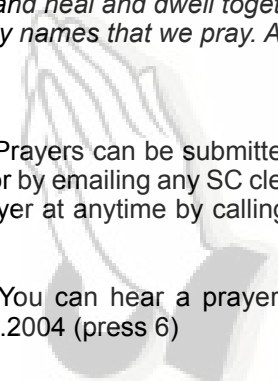

PRAYER FOR THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA (by Rev. Dr. Durrell Watkins)

Dear God, bless this nation and our allies. Bless our troops and our civil servants. Bless our resources and those who call this country home, and please bless our leaders and help them lead us in the ways of peace, justice, and prosperity. Amen.

THE PANDEMIC IS NOT OVER – so Sunshine Cathedral will continue to ask that you reserve your seat at Sunshinecathedral.org if you wish to worship onsite, and we insist that you wear a mask at all times while you are here. We can remain faithful and stay safe at the same time.

BOLD JUSTICE – was established in 2007 with a mission to powerfully address community issues in Broward County through a self-sustaining, interfaith, interracial, proactive organization rooted in religious congregations. Last year BOLD Justice accomplished getting permanent generators into all Nursing homes and assisted Living facilities. We continue to work with Sheriff Gregory Tony and the newly elected Broward State Attorney Mr. Harold Pryor to improve the Civil Citation Program not just for our youth but adults as well. Keeping individuals out of jail not only saves the county money but also allows young adults to continue their lives without a criminal record for a non-violent offense. State Attorney Harold Pryor has committed to attend the next BOLD Justice Nehemiah Action event.

The homeless population in Broward county has exceeded 3,000 and we are working to expand PSH (Permanent Supportive Housing) to get more affordable housing. At our community problems assembly in October Commissioner Dale Holness committed to spearhead an effort to get the county to provide the funding necessary to expand PSH by 200 units. Three other commissioners who were present that evening committed to support his efforts. Commissioner Holness has committed to attend the Nehemiah Action.

The Nehemiah Action will be March 15 via zoom and we need all of our voices to be heard. Please mark your calendar and plan to join us.

February 3rd from 7-8pm we will have a zoom call to begin preparing for the action. Reverend Durrell Watkins will be joining us.

February 23 @ 7:30pm we will have a Rally to announce which officials have committed to attend and what our requests to them will be. Again, this will be via zoom. As a member of BOLD Justice, Sunshine Cathedral is committed making all these things happen. We need your help. Please contact one of the Team Leaders and let us know if you will support Sunshine Cathedral in our mission to create Social Justice. Reverend Ren Bell

DAILY SPIRITUAL PROGRAMMING – Christians & Cocktails (Mondays, 6 pm EST Facebook live), Share in the Chair (Wednesdays, 6 pm Facebook), Sunday worship (Sundays at 10:30 am on Facebook and YouTube), and Midday Prayer (6 days per week, Mon-Sat at Noon EST on Facebook, Thursday MDP includes a brief homily). Ask about A Course in Miracles via Zoom and our community in Second Life. Also join the Sunshine Cathedral New Thought Community on Facebook for short, encouraging messages, affirmations, and prayers. Pray, study, grow with daily reflection, discussion, and prayer.

PRAYER REQUESTS – send prayer requests to prayer@sunshinecathedral.net. You or the person you are praying for will be added to the prayer list for 4 weeks, the prayer list is shared with a team of almost 50 trained prayer chaplains, and it is published weekly (no last names or conditions named) in the Sun Burst for the entire faith community to hold in prayer. The pastoral staff meets weekly and prays for those who are on the prayer list and the board of directors includes the people on the prayer list in their monthly meeting opening prayer. SAINTS OF THE WEEK

January 24: St. Francis de Sales (1567-1622)— Bishop of Geneva, a stronghold of Protestant Calvinism where Catholics were persecuted. Rather than respond defensively, Francis chose to demonstrate love and self-sacrifice in the face of hatred. He helped found an order in which women, rather than living separate cloistered lives, became engaged in helping people in need. He taught that the path to holiness was open to lay persons in the world, not just the clergy. He is known as the patron saint of writers.

Jan 24: Florence Li-Tim Oi (1907 – 1992) - the first woman ordained to the priesthood in the Anglican Communion (Hong Kong, Jan. 24, 1944).

January 25: Apostle Paul – Thirteen books of the New Testament claim to be written by the Apostle Paul (and a fourteenth was once thought to be written by Paul as well). Today, scholarly consensus is that Paul actually only wrote seven epistles that made it into the New Testament. His writings predate the gospels. The First Letter to the Thessalonians is thought to be the oldest book in the New Testament. According to scripture, Paul was a lay scholar who violently opposed the Jesus Movement but who on

the Damascus Road had a mystical experience of Christ and thereafter claimed to be an Apostle commissioned by the Risen Christ to call others to follow the Christ-Way.

January 26: Ss. Timothy & Titus – Companions of the Apostle Paul. The first and second letters to Timothy and the Letter to Titus in the New Testament are traditionally considered to be authored by Paul. We now believe that those three letters were written 50-100 years after the Apostle Paul's death.

January 27: St. John Chrysostom (349-407) - Archbishop of Constantinople, Early Church Father. He is known for the Divine Liturgy of Saint John Chrysostom. The Eastern Orthodox, together with the Byzantine Catholics, hold him in special regard. In the Roman Catholic Church he is recognized as a Doctor of the Church. The Coptic Church also recognizes him as a saint.

January 28: St. Thomas Aquinas (1225 CE – 1274 CE) – Theologian and Dominican Friar. His Summa Theologiae was the first attempt to write a complete, systematic theology. He was influenced by the Greek philosophy of Aristotle.

January 30: Mohandas K. Gandhi (1869 – 1948) – Proponent of non-violent resistance to systems of oppression. His philosophy and activism sparked the movement for Indian independence from Great Britain. He was a Hindu but also an admirer of Jesus Christ (though he rejected the dogmatic claims of Christianity) and his example inspired U.S. Civil Rights Leader Martin Luther King, Jr.

The Prayer Garden with Remembrance Brick is located directly behind the Walt Lawrence & Stephen Lewis Center for Worship and the Arts.

The Prayer Garden is beautifully maintained by our wonderful volunteers that make up the Garden Team. They are generally on the campus each Saturday morning doing various work to maintain the Prayer Garden so that it is always accessible and attractive year round.

There are benches located in the Prayer Garden for those who wish to spend a little extra time.
