STREAMING BROADCAST DRIVE – July is our month to focus on our streaming broadcast ministry. Your support is needed and appreciated.

Sunshine Cathedral's streaming broadcasts received over 5 million views in 2020 and we hope to have even more in 2021. A snapshot of just one week in June (2021) showed that our online programming was being viewed in over 6,000 locations in the U.S. and almost 650 other locations throughout the world (in places such as the UK, Belize, Canada, Brazil, Australia, Mexico, Philippines, Jamaica, etc., and that's just people viewing via Facebook... remember, we are also on YouTube and Instagram!).

We can verify viewers in 39 countries! Of course, we are reaching people close to home, too. We have a strong online viewership in Fort Lauderdale and 19 other Florida towns/cities.

Fort Lauderdale and its neighbors make the largest metropolitan area to follow our streaming ministry with the next largest viewing groups in the U.S. found in NYC, LA, San Francisco, Chicago, Dallas, Philadelphia, and San Antonio. Beyond the U.S. the largest viewership by city comes from Belize City, Sao Paulo, Toronto, London, and Sydney. Millions of viewers in thousands of locations all over Broward County, the state of Florida, the United States, and the world have found and been encouraged by Sunshine Cathedral. And now, people from all over the world can become part of the Cathedral community through the new Sunshine Cathedral Global Fellowship program. Our professionally produced broadcasts helped us thrive in pandemic and helped us help others who were frightened or lonely in pandemic. And our broadcasts have brought the joy and hope that our progressive, positive, practical spirituality offers to people: gay, lesbian, bi, pansexual, straight, questioning, cisgender, transgender, non-binary and all kinds of people all over the world.



SAINTS OF THE WEEK

July 11: Agnes Galer (1860-1939)—ordained a Divine Science minister by New Thought pioneer Nona Brooks (c. 1907) and established a church in Seattle. Galer is known for being the minister who ordained Ernest Holmes (Holmes was a Divine Science minister before starting the Religious Science movement).

July 12: H. Emilie Cady (1848 – 1941) – author of spiritual texts, including Lessons in Truth, one of the most widely read books in New Thought spirituality. She was a homeopathic physician. In one of her books she declared, “I AM’...is God’s name...I AM cannot be weary, or faint, or powerless; for I AM is all-life, all-power, All-Good...’I AM’ spoken upward, toward the good, the true, is sure to out-picture in visible good, in success, in happiness.”

July 14: Kathleen Besly (1858 – 1946) – Divine Science minister who wrote the classic, The Divine Art of Living, in which she writes, “We cannot fear anything or anybody if we have the full realization that God is everywhere, that God is Love and that Love is the great power of life.”
