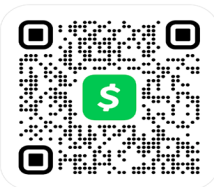

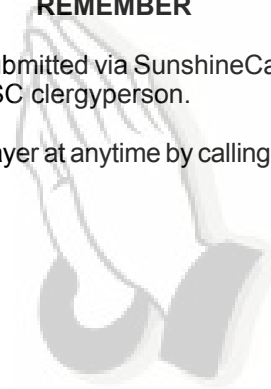

SunBurst Cathedral News: LGBTQ+ PRIDE EDITION

BE PROUD OF WHO GOD CREATED YOU TO BE – Pride Month commemorates the Stonewall Riots (1969) that solidified the Gay Rights Movement. Troy Perry founded Metropolitan Community Churches (a church founded by and with an affirming outreach to LGBTQ people) almost 9 months before Stonewall. Marsha P. Johnson (identified at the time as a gay man and drag queen) was a key figure at the Stonewall Uprising, as was self-identified “butch lesbian” Storme’ DeLarverie. A year after Stonewall, the first Gay Pride Parade was held in NYC.

The LGBTQ+ community celebrates Pride Month to counter-act the shame imposed on them and the abuse they have suffered from political, social, and religious factions throughout history, to highlight major Queer figures who have contributed to American and World history, to encourage people to “come out of the closet” if it is safe to do so, and to demand equal opportunity and equal protection for all (obviously to include LGBTQ people).

In the U.S., religious groups that fully accept and affirm LGBTQ people include: Alliance of Baptists, Association of Welcoming & Affirming Baptists, Community of Christ, Conservative Judaism, Divine Science Federation International, Episcopal Church, Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, International Council of Community Churches, Metropolitan Community Churches, Presbyterian Church USA, Quakers, Reconstructionist (Reconstructing) Judaism, Reform Judaism, Swedenborgians, The Fellowship of Affirming Ministries, Unitarian Universalist Association, United Church of Christ, Unity Church, Unity Fellowship of Christ, many Disciple of Christ churches, some Moravian churches, and more. Sunshine Cathedral has formal relationships with three of these denominations (our senior minister is the president of one of them, the Divine Science Federation).

Sunshine Cathedral teaches that all gender identities are part of the divine image, that the Soul, not genitalia, determines gender, and that love, not gender identities, makes a relationship holy.

Lesbians, Gays, Bisexuals, Transgender folk, Queer people, Questioning, Asexuals, Queer & *Trans Allies, Pansexual people, Gender Queer, Non-binary, Intersex and more...the entire Rainbow of Humanity deserves to take pride in their gifts, talents, and the abundance of love they have to share. **YOU ARE GOD’S MIRACLE AND NOT GOD’S MISTAKE.** Happy Pride!!

MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS STAND UP FOR TRANSGENDER PEOPLE – (AMA2019) The American Medical Association and 15 additional medical, mental health, nursing and other health care organizations filed a joint friend-of-the-court brief urging the Supreme Court of the United States to rule in favor of protecting transgender individuals from employment discrimination to ensure their physical and mental health. The AMA-led brief cites more than four dozen studies and papers demonstrating the consensus among health care professionals regarding: what it means to be transgender; the protocols for the treatment of gender dysphoria, which include living in accordance with one’s gender identity in all aspects of life; and the predictable harms discrimination poses to the health and well-being of transgender individuals.

PFLAG - PFLAG (Parents and Friends of Lesbians and Gays) “seeks a just world in which all people receive understanding and equal acceptance and protection. PFLAG has and will continue to work to change or establish national and state legislation and policies to establish equality and to end discrimination against LGBTQ and other marginalized communities.”

WHAT DO MENTAL HEALTH PROS SAY ABOUT HOMOSEXUALITY? – The American Medical Association, American Nurses Association, American Academy of Pediatrics, American Counseling Association, American Psychiatric Association, American Psychological Association, American School Health Association, American Association of Social Workers, the Pan American Health Organization, and Mental Health America have all made official statements in support of LGBTQ people and declaring same-sex attraction is not unhealthy or disordered and that discrimination against same-gender loving people and transgender people is harmful to them. These organizations also condemn so-called reparative therapies.

IMPORTANT STATS – The National Alliance on Mental Health reports that 40% of LGBTQ adults have had a family member or close friend reject them, 86% of LGBTQ youth have been harassed or assaulted at school, and only 37% LGBTQ youth believe their home to be a safe place for them.

Worship & Square Saftey - We are all aware of the ongoing crises of gun violence in our nation. Even houses of worship have been targets.

Our leadership has had active shooter training, and our EMS and law enforcement respond quickly when needed.

We are always watching for signs of potential danger. If you see something, please say something immediately to one of our key staff leaders, Rev Dr Robert, Rev Dr Anne Atwell, Rev Kevin Tisdol, Darren Loli, or Peggy Brereton.

We don't expect problems but we do want you to be assured that we are prepared as we can be. We are committed to keeping Sunshine Cathedral Square a safe space for all.

Sunshine Cathedral Choir - When will it return? The short answer is, we don't really know.

The newest goal is Autumn. This will be the 2nd attempt to fully bring back the choir. If there are 14 or more people interested in rehearsing and singing weekly (and year round), and if there are no new waves of COVID infections, then it can certainly happen.

The choir was disbanded in Pandemic (close singing is still not recommended and concerts are still being canceled as performers test positive for the coronavirus) and after 2 and a half years on hiatus, it will take time and effort to return to the rhythm of weekly rehearsals and singing every Sunday.

While the choir has been out, choir members have experienced work changes, address changes, relationship changes, health changes, etc. and, therefore, not all will be able to return.

The "old choir" may be gone, but a "new choir" (to include as many members of the "old choir" as wish to be in it) is possible. This will also be an opportunity for new people to get involved in the music ministry.

We wish to express continued gratitude to our Co-Music Ministry Leaders (Sara & Barbara) for doing an excellent job and many thanks to the currently configured Music Staff for their continued support of

the music program and the overall ministry of Sunshine Cathedral.

Change was forced upon us, and the past cannot be recaptured, but something new and amazing can emerge and we are excited for the opportunity. We have amazing professional musicians (vocalists & instrumentalists) producing concert quality music every week, and when we can add a committed, volunteer choir to that, the level of excellence will rise even higher.

When the call to return to rehearsals is made, we hope that seasoned choir members and NEW folk as well will consider adding their voices to our Sunshine Cathedral Music Ministry.

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

June 27: Righteous Warriors of the Stonewall Uprising - The Stonewall Riots, also called the Stonewall Uprising and Stonewall Rebellion, began in the early hours of June 28, 1969 when NYC police raided the Stonewall Inn, a gay club in Greenwich Village. The raid sparked a riot as police roughly forced employees and patrons out of the bar, leading to six days of protests and violent clashes with law enforcement outside the bar on Christopher Street and in nearby Christopher Park. The Stonewall Riots served as a catalyst for the gay rights movement.

June 29: Apostles Peter and Paul— Peter was a commercial fisher. Jesus gave him the nickname of 'rock,' and in the Catholic tradition he is considered the first Pope. Paul, on the other hand, was not one of Jesus' original followers. He helped persecute the first Christians. After his conversion he wrote the first books of the Christian Scriptures as letters to churches he founded. He and Peter often did not get along. Peter and Paul both are thought to have been executed in Rome.

July 1: Anna Pauline "Pauli" Murray (1910 – 1985) – Pauli was a civil rights pioneer, feminist, author, attorney, and first Black woman ordained a priest in the Episcopal Church. Pauli didn't speak openly very often about their sexuality but Pauli did have romantic relationships with women and Pauli also identified personally beyond the traditional gender binary categories. In 2012 Dr. Murray was uplifted as a holy person of God ("saint") by the Episcopal Church. Pauli held three law degrees and was also a seminary graduate.

July 2: Elizabeth Sands Turner (1897 – 1979) – was the director of the Unity Training School, a teacher of metaphysical bible interpretation, the author of three books, and finally, a parish minister in Florida.
