LIVE BROADCAST DRIVE – One of the most important things Sunshine Cathedral has done in recent years is to professionally stream our worship services and other events. In partnership with Happening Out Television Network, our Sunday services can now be seen on Facebook, YouTube, Amazon Fire, Apple TV, Google TV, and Roku. This has taken a big investment of time, creativity, and financial resources and the payoff has been that during pandemic we never missed a service and those who experience our services multiplied exponentially.

In 2020 Five Million people experienced Sunshine Cathedral, and in 2021 that number grew to Six Million. People all over the world worship with us every week. Lives have been touched and changed, and people who have never been to Fort Lauderdale now depend on the encouragement and joy that our ministry offers. It's important and we are thrilled by the result.

GLOBAL READING – Rather than a “contemporary” reading, today we have a reading from the Zen spiritual tradition, a story about being fully present in the moment and enjoying what the moment offers, no matter how frightening the future may seem to be.

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

July 18: Nancy Ledins (1932 – 2017) – a Roman Catholic priest who had gender confirmation surgery in 1979, making her both a woman priest and a transgender priest in the Catholic Church! She didn't try to continue her priestly ministry after her transition, but later in life did volunteer ministry at a Baptist church (American Baptist).

July 20: St. Wilgefortis – a noblewoman who was a devout Christian, Wilgefortis' father betrothed her to a non-Christian king. One night she prayed to be spared from the marriage and the next morning she woke to discover he had a full beard. The king canceled the wedding, and her father, furious, had Wilgefortis crucified. Her cult can be traced to the 1300s, but images of a crucified bearded woman (or a man in woman's dress) from the 11th century have been found. Wilgefortis was removed from the official roster of Catholic saints in 1969 but remains popular in some regions. She is considered a “folk saint.” Wilgefortis is embraced by some who self-identify as transgender, gender queer, gender non-conforming, or intersex because the story of Wilgefortis challenges to gender binary norms.

Tammy Faye – (Tamara {Tammy} Faye Messner née LaValley, formerly Bakker, March 7, 1942 – July 20, 2007) - was an American religious figure, singer, author, and television personality known for her glamorous style and affable personality. She initially gained notoriety for her work with The PTL Club, a religious television program she co-founded in 1974 with her husband, Pentecostal minister Jim Bakker.

Jim Bakker was imprisoned for fraud and conspiracy in 1989. Tammy Faye divorced Bakker in 1992 and married Roe Messner. She was diagnosed with colon cancer in 1996, with which she struggled off and on for years before dying in 2007.

At a time when Evangelical and Pentecostal evangelists were openly antagonistic toward Queer people, Tammy Faye was known for being supportive of LGBTQ+ persons and compassionate toward people living with HIV/AIDS. Tammy Faye made history in the 1980s by being very kind and pastoral to Rev. Steve Pieters, a gay minister living with AIDS, as she interviewed him on her television program.

July 21: Albert Luthuli (1898-1967) — Zulu chief, Nobel laureate. An important early leader in the struggle against apartheid, Luthuli was a Zulu chief raised in a Christian home. He became a principle leader in the African National Congress, and was frequently imprisoned for leading strikes and boycotts, and burning his passbook. In 1960 he was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize. The driving force in his work was his personal faith in God and belief that, despite how things looked in South Africa, justice would one day prevail.

July 22: St. Mary Magdalene — “Apostle to the Apostles.” Mary of Magdala (near Capernaum) was one of a group of women who traveled and worked with Jesus. The Gospels report Jesus healed her by casting out seven evil spirits. Her life was forever changed, and she followed him all the way to the cross, even when the men had fled in fear. She has long been the subject of sacred art and literature, and been an important model for the leadership and role of women in the church. She reminds us that there were many women leaders among Jesus’ first followers. Despite later myths, there is nothing in the bible to indicate she had been a prostitute.
